 be equally divided among the heirs of my
 body my wife to share equally with each
 heir: And in case she dies, it is my
 will that all my property both personal &
 real shall be sold and the proceeds be
 equally divided between the heirs of my
 body

I hereby constitute and appoint my
 son Joseph W. Story Executor of this my
 last will & testament

Whereas Josiah B. Story has this day exhibited in

 Witness further testified that said testator
 was of sound and disposing mind and
 memory at the time of the execution of
 said will and signed the same freely
 & voluntarily. Wherefore it is ordered by the
 court that said will be declared to be the
 last will and testament of said deceased
 & the same be admitted to record in
 common form of law as such.
