In the name of God Amen,
I Hiram Davis of said State and County being
of advanced age, and knowing that I must shortly
depart this life, deem it right and proper that
I should make a disposition of the property with
which a kind providence has blessed me:
do therefore make this my last will and testa-
ment hereby revoking all others made by me;

Item 1

I desire and direct that my body be buried
in a decent and christianlike manner suitable
to my circumstances and conditions in life.
My soul, I trust, shall return to God who gave it.

Item 2

I desire and direct that my just debts be
paid without delay by my Executors hereinafter
appointed; as I am unwilling my creditors should
be delayed in their rights especially as there is
no necessity for delay.

Item 3

It is my will and desire that all my property
both real and personal of every description what-
ever including my interest in the estate of my
deceased husband (Abraham Davis late of
Marion County in said State deceased) after
my death, be sold according to law by my Ex-
ecutors hereinafter named and the proceeds
of the sale thereof be equally divided, share and
share alike among my grand children hereinafter
named (subject to the provisions and limitation
following) to wit one share to each of the orphans
of my then in law father John Prim deceased, viz John
Prim and his sister Sarah, A. P. Love, daughter to
Hiram A. P. Prim, two shares to each of the orphans
of my son Josiah Davis deceased viz Ann Living-
ston formerly Ann Davis, John Davis, Francis
Davis, Julia Davis and William Davis. The share
going to the said Sarah A. P. Love I desire shall
go to her during her natural life with remain-
der to her children should she have any, but should
the said Sarah A. P. die without issue then I desire
that her said share should go to and become the
property of the children of the said John Prim,
said share of the said Sarah A. P. Love to be in
no event subject to the debt or liability of her
husband John Love.

Item 4

I have constituted and appointed my much re-
spected friends Daniel Graham of the County
of Marion, and Robert C. Young of the
County of Crawford said State, Executors
of my last will and Testament, hoping
