proper to make a disposition of the property

therefore make this my last will and testament
hereby revoking and annulling all former wills
Item 1st I desire that my body be buried in a decent
and becoming manner suitable to my circumstances
and conditions in life

Item 2nd It is my will and desire that all my just
debts be paid by my Executors hereinafter
named as soon as convenient after my
death

Item 3rd It is my will and desire that my beloved
wife Elizabeth Sales have all my property
of every kind and nature both real and
personal during her natural life or widow-
-hood and at her death to be equally divided
among my three children I share of share alike
viz my sons Leonard G. Sales and William G.
Sales and my daughter Mary Ann Murinder
Elizabeth Sales and my wife is hereby invested
with power to give them off any share or
portion of property at any time she may
think proper or their arriving at the
age of twenty one years or at the time of
their marriage my wife having full power
to manage and controul the property and
to sell any part of it when in her judgment
it will be to the interest of the estate to do
so and to purchase other property of like
value in lieu of the same

Item 4th In the event that my wife should hereafter
marry I desire that my estate be divided my
wife to have two fourths and the residue to
be equally divided among my children
as aforesaid the two fourths going to my
wife to be for her sole and separate use
during her natural life and not to be
subject to the debts contracts or liabilities
of any future husband she may have neither
in law or equity

Item 5th I hereby constitute and appoint my
beloved wife Elizabeth Sales Executor to
execute this will and testament hoping
it will have the same executed
