 acres of land containing all the houses
 last half supposed of the lot No 194 one
 hundred and ninety four provided she does not marry
 and if she should marry said hundred acres
 of land to revert back to the estate and be
 sold and be equally divide with all my heirs
 and after my death I desire that all
 my property should be equally divided
 amongst my heirs.
