William P Webb having procured a paper for probate in Solemn form as the Nuncupative Will of Mary Wallace, deceased, of which the following is a true copy viz;

and whereas it appears to the Court by the Oaths of Martha J. Navel, Sallie J. Greene and Sarah A. M. Buffie three competent witnesses that they were present at the making of said Will and that Mary Wallace did declare in the presence of said witnesses that the contents of said paper was her Will and that said Will was made only a few hours before the death of said Mary Wallace and she was sound in mind knowing what she did and in the time of her last sickness and in the house of William P Webb in Buena Vista when she had been residing more than ten days before the making of said Will, and it further appearing to the Court that said Mary Wallace departed this life on the nineteenth day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Sixty five and that the substance of said Will was reduced to writing within thirty days after the speaking of the same and that the application for the Probate of said Will was made before the Court within six months after the death of said Mary Wallace, And it further appearing that due and legal notice of the Probate of said Will has been given the only heir at law of said deceased, Corrigill Wallace a non resident, by publication. It is therefore ordered, considered and adjudged that said writing herein before set forth contains the last will and Testament of said Mary Wallace, deceased, and that the same be considered as duly proved in Solemn form of law and admitted to probate.
