Item 3rd I also will my grandson
Walter Jackson have one two year old
heifer yearling also give my granddaughter
Bella Eugene one two year old Sheffer yearling
Item 4th I also will that in case I should
or pass away that the following property
to wit: be disposed of in the following
manner

first I wish to reserve two sows and
pigs for the benefit of the family on
the place, and the balance of the stock
on place I wish sold consisting of
Cows, hogs, and sheep, horses and turkeys
one lot of land No (208) containing
(202¹/₂) two hundred two and one half acres
more or less in the eleventh Dist and
the proceeds of the same to be equally
divided among all the heirs of said
estate after reserving enough to pay
expenses of funeral and burial and also
fifty or sixty Dollars for fixing up
the old kitchen furniture to remain on
the place for the benefit of family

during my wife's widowhood as long
as they remain together; in case of a sep-
aration I wish my wife to have the sewing
machine
and the furniture she brought here the
balance of household & kitchen furniture to
be equally divided between my wife
and daughter Elizabeth
I wish the cane mill Bailer and
Copperator sold and proceeds divided among
the heirs equally
