do here make and publish my last will and
testament hereby revoking all wills heretofore
made by me.

Item 1st It is my desire that my executor herein after

a special legacy of one thousand and five hun-
dred Dollars and to Mrs. Mollie F. Shook a
special legacy of Five Dollars.

Item 3rd Upon the payment for erection of a monument
the specific legacies in this last and all
expenses of administration I dispose of
the remainder of my estate as follows

Item 4th I give and bequeath one fourth (1/4) of my
estate to my sister - Mrs. F. E. Weaver One
fourth (1/4) of my estate to my nephews & nieces
children of my deceased brother Joseph Brown
one sixth of my estate to my nephews & nieces
children of my deceased sister Mrs. S. J. Daniel
I give and bequeath 1/6 of one sixth of my estate
to Mrs. Belle Shook wife of H. M. Stokes

I give and bequeath one ninth (1/9) of my estate
and to my great niece Miss Hatten Shook
I give and bequeath one Eighth of my estate.

Item 4th If either one or both of my sisters afore-
mentioned to wit: Mrs. Ed. Rylander Mrs. F. E. Weaver
should depart this life before I do then it is
my desire that their respective children should
take and inherit their respective portions
of my estate which is herein bequeathed
to their mother or mothers.

Item 5th If any one or more of nephews & nieces children
of my deceased brother Joseph Brown or my
sister Mrs. S. J. Daniel should die leaving chil-
dren then the child or children of such
deceased nephew or niece should take and inherit
that portion of my estate to which the father
or mother should have been entitled under
the will if he or she had been
living.

Item 6th If Mrs. Belle Stokes should die without leaving
children then that portion of my estate herein
willed to her should revert and become a part of

of my estate and be equally divided
between my nephews & nieces.

Item 7th It is my will and desire that my real
estate sitelands and house furniture shall
be sold at public or private sale without an
order of Court, as may seem to my executor
to be most conducive to the interest
of my estate.

Item 8th It is my desire that my niece ^{Mrs} Antony Oliver
have my gold chain
