 revoking all others heretofore made by me
 1st after the decent interment of my body and the
 payment of all my just debts, I desire that all my
 property of every description both real and personal
 shall be divided into nine equal shares or lots
 according to the direction of my executor hereinafter
 appointed or such persons as he may select to make
 such division to each of my sons James M. Thomas
 M. Melton, Benjamin, Ewells, and William, and
 also to my daughter Lucinda Mathis and to my beloved
 wife Nancy Harvey, I will and bequeath each of
 said shares such to them and their heirs forever
 said shares to be assigned to them or selected by them
 according to some judicious plan to be adopted
 by my Executor
 2nd The remaining share or lot of my said estate I
 will and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Harvey
 in trust nevertheless my daughter Abigail Pierson
 and the heirs of her body forever And I desire the
 said property so given in trust to my said daughter
 shall go into and remain in the possession and
 control the use and control of it and Pierson her
 present husband or any future husband that she
 may have so far as consistent with a due
 execution of said trust
 3rd In the event any of my said Children should die leaving
 Children, I desire that these Children should represent
 them and receive their several shares, and in the
 event any of them should die leaving no child that
 the share herein bequeathed to such child should go
 to and be divided among my remaining Children
 share and share alike
 4th I hereby constitute and appoint my son James
 M. Harvey Executor of this my last will & testament
 this August the 24 1868
