Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and christian like manner

Item 2d I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor hereafter named.

Item 3d I hereby give and bequeath to my daughter Charity Pearson and her two youngest daughters Ansah and Martha Pearson all that tract or parcel of land known as the East half of lot m. 19. being in the fourth district of originally Mrs. Cogee but now Marion County the said Charity Pearson to have and hold for the sole benefit of herself and two youngest daughters during the natural life of the said Charity and until said daughters shall have married after which I desire and direct my Executor to sell said land so that all her heirs shall share and share alike

Item 4th I hereby constitute and appoint my son Thomas W. Harvey Executor of this my last will and testament
