I will and beneath unto my wife Elisabeth Pearson my entire stock of horses and cattle all of my household and kitchen furniture also all of my farming tools, also my house have about 12 years old, also my stock of sheep, also my present growing crop, also wheat notes I hold & also annominate and appoint Christopher Pearson my executor on this my last will and testament and authorize him to take charge of all my property for the support of my wife Elisabeth Pearson during her natural life and at her death if there should be any

thing left to be equally divided between my
