

Will and Probate of R. A. Rutherford

State of Georgia Marion County

I, Robt. A. Rutherford of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills heretofore by me made.

Item 1st

I desire that my body be buried in a Christianlike manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life.

Item 2nd

I wish my Executrix as seen as possible after my death to pay my debts if any.

Item 3rd

I give to Homer Bray for taking care of his grandmother, who is my Sister, the following real estate:- Two Hundred and Sixteen (216) acres of land more or less, in the Fifth District of Marion County Ga., known as the Webb place and Bray place.

Item 4th

I give to Elizabeth Stringfellow the remainder of my property consisting of land in the 10th District of said Marion County Ga., also all my money, notes and accounts also all my stock of every kind, horses, mules, cows, hogs &c, also all my household and kitchen furniture.

Item 5th

I do hereby appoint Elizabeth Stringfellow Executrix of this my will.


