

I Richmond Baker of the County of Marion and State of Georgia being disposed to make a will do hereby make and publish this my last Will and Testament revoking all others by me at any time made -

And first - I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Baker all the property I have or may own in any manner whatever at my death. This embraces all that may be due and coming to me from my mother's estate or from any other source said property of what kind ever it may be I do give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Elizabeth Baker in fee simple said property shall not be liable to the debts or contracts of any husband or husbands my beloved daughter may have -

Ist I also appoint my beloved daughter Elizabeth my sole Executrix of this my will - I desire that my Executrix do not make any Return of her act and avows to the Ordinary

I desire the property herein given may be disposed of by will by my beloved daughter Elizabeth and should she die without a will or without leaving a child living at her death that the property go to her nearest relations by blood -
