without delay by my Executor hereafter named

And I also desire and direct, at my death that all
the property of which I am in possession of be sold
and the proceeds divided equally among the heirs to wit
Robert M. Anders, Mahaly E. Anders, Samuel S. Anders,
George W. N. Anders and Franklin N. Anders son of Johanna
M. Anders and Agnes M. Boyt the sum of Ten dollars
she received her part at the time of her marriage.

I hereby constitute and appoint my sons Robert M.
Anders and Samuel S. Anders Executors to this my last
will and testament

This July the twentieth Eighteen Hundred and
seventy three (1873)

L. Clements one of the subscribing witnesses of said will that said Samuel anders did sign seal publish and declare said will to be his last will and that the deceased signed it in the presence of deponent and the other subscribing witnesses and that deponent considered him of sound mind at the time of its execution and that he signed it as his will of his own free will: that witnesses signed it as witnesses in presence of testator and in the presence of each other.

Wherefore it is adjudged that said will is probated in common form of law.
