I Sarah R Toney of said State and County being of advanced age but of sound and disposing mind and memory knowing that I must shortly depart this life accept it right and proper both as respects my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me I do therefore make this my last Will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all others by me heretofore made

First

I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christlike manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life my ^{body} soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it as I hope for salvation through the merit and atonements of our blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

Secondly

I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor hereinafter named and appointed

Thirdly

I give and bequeath and devise to my daughter Mahana F. Bell and to her heirs the West half of Lot of land number one hundred and Eighty nine in the Fifth district of originally of Muscogee now Marion County containing one hundred one and a fourth acres more or less with all the rights members and appertinances to said land in any wise belonging free from all charge and limitation whatever to her own proper use benefit and behoof for ever with full power to dispose of the same by will or otherwise as they may deem proper together with all of my House hold and kitchen furniture with the money that I may leave and all other effects not named in this will that may be belonging to me

Toney sign said will and declare said paper as her last will and testament and that she signed the same in the presence of the other witnesses to wit J. Bell and Rees M. Epps and that they all signed said in the presence of each other and of said deceased at her request that she reconsidered her former mind at the time of the execution of said paper

Wherefore it is ordered by the Court that said paper be declared to be the last will and testament of Sarah R. Toney and that the same be admitted to record in Common form of law
