First: I Commit my Soul to God who gave it and my body I desire to be buried in a decent manner, and my worldly affairs Estate I dispose of as follows;

Item 1st I have given my children Isaac P. Blue and Phebe A. E. Stewart, all that I design giving them, and what I have given Phebe A. E. Stewart and what she will get here after, I give and bequeath free from of the disposition of her present or any future husband, and her, Phebe A. E. Stewart, part at her death to be divided between her children.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Martha J. Blue, all the property that I may be in possession of wherever and whatever it may be, during her natural life or widow-hood, of which I may die possessed. And if she, my wife, should marry, I direct that all the property herein bequeathed to, her be sold or divided equally between her and my children, Isaac P. Blue and Phebe A. E. Stewart, but if she, my wife, should die without marriage, then and in that case I direct that the property be equally divided between my children Isaac P. Blue and Phebe A. E. Stewart and her, (Phebe A. E. Stewart) part to be free from the disposition of her present or any future husband.

Item 3rd I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Martha J. ~~Stewart~~ Blue, my son Isaac P. Blue and my son in law William T. Stewart, my Executors and Executors to this my last Will and Testament.
