

WILL OF SOLOMON F. PHILLIPS

GEORGIA MARION COUNTY:-

In the Name of God Amen:-

I Solomon F. Phillips of the County & State aforesaid being of sound and disposing mind and memory, but being advanced in years know that I must shortly depart this life, deem it proper that I make disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me; do make and execute this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other-wills by me heretofore made.

Item 1

I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian-like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life, my Soul I trust shall return to Rest with the God who gave it, as I hope for Salvation through the merits and atonements of the blessed Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

It is my wish and desire that all my just debts be paid by my executor hereafter named, so soon after my death as the same may be practically done.

Third

After the payment of my debts as above provided for, I give to my wife Cynthia Jane all of my property of every description for and during her natural life to be used by her as she sees proper, except that she has no authority to sell any of my lands.

Fourth

I give bequeath and devise to my son Cater Netris after the death of my beloved wife the North half of Lots of Land No. Two & Thirty One in the Fourth Dist. of said County and at his death to his children and if he has no children then to his nearest relatives.

Fifth

I give bequeath and devise to my son Bartley Ellis after the death of my beloved wife the South half of Lots of Land Nos. Two & Thirty one in the 4th Dist. of said County and at his death to his children and if he has no children then to his nearest relatives.

Sixth

I give bequeath and devise unto my two daughters Laura Brady & Rena Roberts my two feather beds one each.

Seventh

After the death of my beloved wife and after the items abovementioned have been given to those named; I give bequeath & devise to all of my children all of my estate share and share alike.

Eighth

I hereby nominate and appoint my son W. F. Phillips & my son S. E. J. Phillips and my son-in-law, G. D. Perry Executors of this my last will and testament. Signed sealed declared & published as the last Will and Testament of Solomon F. Phillips on this the 10th day of August 1907 in the presence of the witnesses whose names are subscribed below, who attested the same as subscribing witnesses in presence of Solomon F. Phillips and in the presence of each other, that they saw said Solomon F. Phillips subscribe his name thereto and that they subscribed their names as attesting witnesses at the special instance and request of the said Solomon F. Phillips.
