knowing that I must shortly depart this
life deem it right and proper both as res-
pects my family and myself, That I should
make a disposition of the property which
a kind Providence has blessed me,
I do therefore make this my last will
and testament hereby making and annulling
all others by me heretofore made.

First, I desire ~~to be~~ and direct that my body
be buried in a decent and Christian-
like manner and suitable to my circumstan-
ces in ~~life~~ and condition in life.

My Soul I trust shall return to rest with
God who gave it, as I hope for salvation
through the merits and atonement of the
blessed Lord and savior Jesus Christ,

Second I desire and direct that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my executor herein
after-named and appointed

Third I give bequeath and devise to my nephew
Eugene J. Mathis, twenty shares of my stock in
the Buena Vista Loan and Savings Bank said
Bank located in Buena Vista, Marion County
Georgia. Also the notes I hold against him three
in number, one for two hundred and thirty
and $\frac{5}{100}$ dollars dated January 25th 1899, with
certain credits, one for three hundred and
thirty one and $\frac{25}{100}$ dollars, dated December 4th
1894, and one due bill dated Aug 3rd 1899
for twenty dollars with all the interests that
have or may accrue upon the same.

Fourth I give bequeath and devise to Belle Stokes
my adopted daughter and to my nephews
and nieces named to wit, Anna C. Rylander.
Sue McLaughlin, Clara J. Mathis, Della
Poster, Children of my sister Louisa Mathis
Mahala A. Butt, Moses Haney, James M. Haney,
Jessie Haney, Thomas Hardy and many will
be latter Children of my brother James M. Haney.
Berganin Haney, Josephine Chittie Haney,
David Williams nee Haney, Ross Crawford nee
Haney, Robert Haney, William Haney, Clara
Haney, Mary Ann Haney and Lizzie Hunt
Haney Children of my brother William Haney

Carrie Talley nee Hanay, daughter of my brother Benjamin Hanay, Thomas Pearson, Mitten Pearson, Susan Pearson and Martha Pearson. Children of my sister Charity Pearson, share and share alike the entire amount both real and personal received by me as a legacy under the will of my brother Evan Hanay dec'd late of Putnam County Georgia.

Said amount to be carried out of my estate and paid as directed in this article of my will. I make this request thus because I know that it was the wish of my deceased brother that I should do so.

Fifth I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Mary M. Hanay after the payment of the largest set forth in Article Third and Fourth of this my last will and testament one half my estate both real and personal to her own proper use and benefit and behoof forever in fee simple with full power to dispose of the same by will otherwise as she may deem proper. I further bequeath and direct that in the half thus absolutely given and devised, that the House and lot in which I now live, known as lot number — Block — in the plan of said town of Buena Vista shall be a part taken at men an amount as the appraisers of my estate shall please upon it including all the furniture and household goods in the house at my death.

Sixth I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Mary M. Hanay for and during her natural life to rents, profits, interests and dividends of the remaining half of my estate and at her death to be divided equally among the persons named in Article 4th of this my will and testament, to wit my adopted daughter therein named and my nephews and nieces therein named, with the reservation and restriction hereafter made. Said half my estate mentioned and devised in this Article to be held in for the uses and purposes declared by Evan S. Mathis, who, is hereby appointed trustee to hold and invest the same as shall be for the best interest of the best give trust.

Seventh Inasmuch as many of those to whom I have made requests in this my will are now indebted to me by note and in other ways or MADE BY WILLIAM HANAY indebted to me before my death, it is my will and desire, and I do direct that each and all said debts

now owing a sum as may be created hereafter shall be fully paid by the legatee so owing, or they shall not have any interest in my estate. and the amount that would have been received shall go back into the corpus of my estate to be divided equally among those who are not indebted to my estate. I further direct that the bequest made to Carrie Talley nee Harry shall not be paid to her unless the indebtedness her husband William Talley shall be fully paid off to my estate.

The specific legacy made to Evan T. Mathis not covered by this article - I hereby nominate and appoint my nephew Evan T. Mathis of Marion County Georgia, my executor to carry out this my last will and testament carrying the foregoing six pages, indented this January 23rd 1870
