

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF THOMAS B. JOSSEY

State of Georgia marion County

I, Thos. B. Jessey of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all others, by me heretofore made.

Item 1st

I wish my executors hereinafter named to pay my debts as soon as possible after my death, and that they erect a suitable slab over my grave

Item 2nd

I give to the children of my deceased Sister Elizabeth Newsome, namely, Mary, Lucinda, Ada, James and samuel, Two hundred (\$200.00) Dollars each.

Item 3d.

I give to the children of my deceased Sister, sarah Highnote, namely Jessey Highnote and Francis Highnote Story, Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars each, and also to the widow of J. F. Highnote (Cora Highnote) Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

Item 4th

I give to the widow of my deceased brother J. H. Jessey, Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars.

Item 5th

I give to my niece Mrs. Mattie Jessey Avant, Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars

Item 6th

I give to my brother W. B. Jessey, Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars.

Item 7th

I give to my brother J. M. Jessey, Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars.

Item 8th

I give to my Nephew Henry Highnote the sum of Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars and also my land known as the Highnote place in the Buena Vista, District of Marion County State of Georgia.

Item 9th

I desire that the remainder of my estate if there be any, that the same be equally divided between my nephews and nieces, of my two brothers, Wm. B. Jessey and J. H. Jessey.

Item 10th

I do hereby constitute and appoint my nephew Henry Highnote and Chas. W. Lowe, Executors of this my last will and Testament, and that they shall be allowed to wind up my said estate without giving any bond, and without making returns to the Court.
