I give and bequeath to my son James and four daughters, Martha Proctor, Rachel Carter, Mittie McGarrah and Strichey Harvey an equal division of all other property that I may possess at my death.

Fifthly

I constitute and appoint my son James McGarrah and son in law Moses McGarrah Executors of this my last will and testament this 22nd day of April 1887
