widowhood until one of my children becomes
twenty one years of age or until one of
daughters marry, then it is my will and desire
that my Executrix shall set off and pay over
to said heir, the proper distributive share
that is due to him or her, still retaining the bal-
ance in her hands and managing the same
until an other become competent by age
or marriage to receive his or her share which
shall in like manner be paid over as before
mentioned, and continue on in this manner
