life or widowhood all my property that
I may have at my death and at her mar-
riage or death to be equally divided between
th my heirs.

4 I hereby constitute and appoint
my beloved wife Delia Jane, Ex^{or}, and my
worthy friend Christopher Pearson Ex^{or} of
this my last will and testament
