

Last Will and Testament of Nancy Goins

State of Georgia, I, Nancy Goins being of advanced age
McDuffie County, } and wish to dispose of such property
as a kind providence has blessed me
do make this my last will and Testament, and hereby revoke
all others heretofore made by me;

Item I. After consigning my body to the dust from whence
it came, and my spirit to the God that gave it, I wish and
desire my body buried in a manner suitable to my Con-
stitution in life;

Item II. I will and bequeath all of my debts to be paid as soon
after my death as possible by my executor hereafter mentioned;

Item III. I give and bequeath to Mary J. Kendrick wife of Henry
Kendrick my horse or brown mare, two cows three yearlings three
beds and bed clothes, and all of the balance of my household
and kitchen furniture, except what is hereafter willed away,
all of the above property is willed to Mary Kendrick as aforesaid
to her and the heirs of her body, for their own use and benefit, not
subject to the debts and contracts of Henry Kendrick or any one else;

Item IV. I give and bequeath to Ida Roberts, one Bed and Bed-
clothes, to be taken care of by her Aunt, Mary Kendrick as aforesaid
and should she depart this life without marrying or having children
the bed to belong to Mary Kendrick, subject to the same rules and reg-
ulation as the balance I have given her;

Item V. I give and bequeath to Mary Elizabeth Roberts the bal-
ance of my estate, such as the debts due me, and such other in-
comes as I may be favored with;

I hereby nominate constitute, and appoint my friend John
B. Sutton to carry into effect this my will and testament,
