

The Last Will and Testament of
John M. Ragunby.

State of Georgia,
Warren County, }

In the Name of God. Amen!

I, John M. Ragunby, of the County and State aforesaid, being of sound, disposing mind and memory, do make, ordain and appoint this instrument in writing, to be my Last Will and Testament.

Item first: It is my will and desire, that all my just debts shall be paid out of my Estate.

Item second: I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Harriet Ragunby, all that tract or parcel of land, whereon I now live, containing Thirty and a half acres, be the same more or less, lying partly in Warren County, Georgia, and adjoining lands of the Estate of John Wilson and James R. Wilson; also, all my house hold and kitchen furniture, stock of all kinds, that I may die seized and possessed of Carriage and harness, Wagon and gear, Plows, plow gear, blacksmith tools, &c. &c. all cash or money on hand at the time of my death, notes and accounts.

Item third: I have given unto my daughter, Georgia A. Booker, Twenty and Twenty acres of land in Warren County. I hereby confirm the same to her, agreeable to the Deed made.

Item fourth: I have given unto my daughter, Harriet A. Howell, Thirty and

deed and Thirty eight acres of land in Warren County. I hereby confirm the same to her, agreeable to the Deed made.

Item fifth: I have given unto my three grand children, William T., Joseph B., and John P. Lagasby, ninety acres of land in Warren County. I hereby confirm the same unto them, agreeable to the Deed made.

Item sixth: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife, Harriet Lagasby, my Executrix, to carry into effect this my last Will and Testament.

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this the Thirtieth day of September, (1867) One Thousand, Eight Hundred, and Sixty seven.
