and H. C. M^cKinney, were on the 11th day of May, in the Year of
our Lord, Eighteen Hundred and Seventy Three, at the residence of Henry
M^cKinney, in Warren County and said State, when Lucinda Wiley,
in her last illness, and in perfect possession of her mind and fac-
ulties, as appeared to us, called to the bystanders and upon us in
particular, to remember and take notice of what she was about
to say, when she said: I wish all my just debts paid; and all
of my estate to be left together and controlled by my son H. C.
M^cKinney, my daughter, Fannie M^cKinney, and my son Wiley,
according to age, or mature. I also wish my said son, A. E. M^cKinney,
to remain on my place in M^cCluff County, and to act as
my Executor, and to take special care of my two daughters.
I also want my grandson, James Wiley M^cKinney, to have
the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) out of my estate, soon after
which she died, and on the 23rd day of May following, this
Will was reduced to writing as herein set forth.
