herein bequeathed to my Sister Mary Magruder
and my great Niece Mary Ann C. Magruder

Item third I give and bequeath to Thomas C.
Magruder Two hundred dollars
which he has borrowed

Item fourth I give and bequeath to my three

great Nieces viz Nancy Jones

William Mary Ann William and Asiah A. Brown
one hundred dollars each, and I appoint my
trusty friend Josiah Brown Trustee for the
said Three hundred dollars herein bequeathed
to my said three Nieces

Item fifth I give and bequeath to the afore-

said Mary C. Magruder my Bed

and Bedstead to be given to her whenever my
Sister Mary Magruder shall think proper
