of nineteen years a horse worth seventy
five dollars a saddle and bridle worth \$12.00
I also desire that Mary J. Garrett my
daughter shall have at the age of
Eighteen a horse worth \$45.00 dollars and a
saddle and a bridle worth \$13 dollars and
I desire that Hannah J. Garrett my daughter
shall have at the age of Eighteen years one
horse worth \$45 dollars and a saddle and
bridle worth \$13 dollars
