of the County and State aforesaid being of sound
Mind and disposing Memory do appoint this
my last will and Testament.

First. It is my will that the whole of my property
including my real and personal Estate do es. And
every other species of my property shall be distributed
into four equal Shares either by actual division
of the same or disposing of it at Public Sale
and dividing of the same as my executors here-
inafter may think proper for the benefit of
my heirs in his discretion they deem advisable.

Second It is my will that of said property
my wife Polly Stendall shall have one
fourth share the use of which she shall have
during her Natural life and after death the
residue I give bequeath and devise to my heirs
hereinafter mentioned.

Third Of the other shares remaining of my property
I hereby give bequeath and devise to my son
Franklin Stendall (except five hundred
dollars I desire to be taken from his distributive
share and give to Martha Underwood and
Mary Stendall it being money expended for
him in his education more than was given to
them in contribution to him and to hold
forever in fee simple.

Fourth I give and bequeath and devise one share
of my property together with one third of my
wife's share remaining after her death to
Clark H. Parks in trust for the education and
benefit of my daughter Martha Underwood
during her life time and after death the same
to be divided equally among her children in
equal proportions.

Fifth I give bequeath and devise one share of my
said property together with one third of my wife's
share remaining after her death to be held by Parky
in Trust for the education and benefit of my
daughter Mary Kendall during her life and
after her death to her children in equal proportions
and if she dies without issue I desire that her
proportion of my estate go to Martha Underwood's
children and to my son Franklin if he ever
has any.

Sixth I hereby give bequeath and devise my
interest in my Father's Estate now in the hands
of my Brother James Kendall of Fayette County
and my interest in Brother James property
individually to the children of Elisha H. Kendall
of Alabama to have and to hold from inheritance.

Seventh It is further my wish that the said Trustee E. H.
Parky shall have discretionary power to invest appropriate
and employ the said property conveyed in Trust—
as aforesaid as he may conceive to be interest and
well fare of my daughters Mary and Martha and
their children.

Eighth I hereby constitute and appoint Elisha H. Parky
my sole executor to carry into effect the provisions
of this my last will and Testament.

The following persons that are now on the plantation The Waggon and Harness, Four Horses - viz. a Bay Horse North, do Dare a Sorrel do Bill, a black do. And also a mule. After the death of the
