Item the second I desire and direct that
 all my Just debts be paid without
 delay by my Executors hereinafter named
 as I shall be willing my Creditors should
 be delayed of their Rights especially as
 there is no necessity for delay

Item the third I give and devise to my
 three Daughters Elizabeth R Heath
 Sarah J Heath and Susanna E Heath all
 of my property both personal and real and
 all my Household furniture to be equally
 divided and all of my Stock of any kind
 that I may own at my death and also
 all Monies Notes and accounts and
 every thing appertaining to my Estate to be
 equally divided between my three Daughters
 and if either of my said Daughters should

should be divided between the two others herein
