Witnesseth, That the said James W. Head for and in consideration of the sum of Five  
Dollars or else

Dollars, in hand paid at ~~and~~ before the sealing and delivery  
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has <sup>been and confirmed</sup> granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and  
by these presents, do ~~as~~ grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said <sup>John and Dennis</sup> part of the second part,  
<sup>of H. J. C. L. and</sup> all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of <sup>to wit:</sup> be bearing  
said State.

near top of hill north west of my residence on road leading from Flat-Shoots to Rocky Mount at a certain corner designated by rock, running North with public road one hundred yards, thence East seventy five yards, thence South one hundred yards, thence West forty yards to starting point, said to contain one & three fourteenth acres, more or less, situated in middle ninth Dist of Morrisania Co, Ga.

It is agreed by all that when above described lands shall cease to be used for school purposes for white children that it shall then revert to me or my assigns, or legatees, with all improvements or appendages connected thereto,

To Have and to Hold the said bargained premises, together with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances thereto, to the same being belonging or in anywise appertaining, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof as above described Trustees or executors to said part of the second part, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns in fee simple.

And the said George W. Head, dale, his heirs, executors and administrators, the said bargained premises unto the said George W. Head, his heirs, executors, and administrators, and all and every other person or persons, shall and will warrant and forever defend by virtue of these presents.
