of Sound and disposing Mind and Memory do make
publick and declare this as my last Will and
Testament, thereby revoking all others formerly
by me made.

Item 1st My Will is that my just debts shall be
all paid and burial expenses and the
expenses of Executing of this Will. And that the
Balance of my Estate both real and personal,
Notes, accounts, and Money shall all be equally
divided among My Sisters Children (Except John
Keith and Wm B Keith my Nephews), who I will
Nothing But their portions to be equally divided
between their children from the date of this
Will each legatee receiving my and all
debt and that I hold against him or her
at my death as that much Money even if
out of date.

Item 2^d I do hereby make and appoint Vincent
F. Cassette of the County of Monroe (then)
Wm Dow of the County of Jasper Georgia Daniel
of the County of Heard and Daniel Keith
of the County of Meriwether all of the State
aforesaid each and all of them my Executors
to execute this my last Will and Testament.

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this thirtieth
day of Sept in the year of our Lord
Eighteen hundred and fifty three (1853)
