Smith of the Town of Woodbury, and of the County of Marionette in the State of Georgia party of the second part; Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred (\$300) dollars Dollars to be in hand paid by the said party of the second part; the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, Bargained and sold to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, the following described land, to wit: Commencing at an iron post running South, seventy yards to another iron post, thence West to an iron post thence East seventy yards to the place of beginning, the same being a part of Lot No. 68 in the Lower Ninth district of Marionette County, and containing one Acre; and bounded North, by Lands of W. S. Williams Thence East by Lands of Sutton Gil & Williams, Thence South by Sutton, Gil & Williams, thence west by street. To have and to hold the said Parcel of land with the house upon it, together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any way appertaining to the only proper use benefit and behoof of G. W. Smith, the said party of the second part his heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns in fee Simple;

And the said parties of the first part do hereby fully warrant the title to said land and will defend the same Against the lawful Claims of all persons whomsoever.
