I give and bequeath to my children
Joseph Sewell Fitch Gibbs Rich and J. Sewell
Larissa H. Claylock Margaret Holcomb

and the children of my son James H.
Sewell the residue of my property after
the payment of all my just debts to be

equally divided among them

Item 3^d It is my will and desire that
Rich and J. Sewell and William C.

Gibbs act as Executors to this my last
Will and Testament and I do hereby
appoint them as such and request

that it be faithfully carried out by them.
