

I know all men by their
Meriwether County I presently that I John
William afflicted in body
and intend to leave this as a deed of
property to my beloved wife Lavinia Wilson
and her children forever.

Item 1st I leave them one half of Lot Number
in the Ninth district of formerly
Troup now Meriwether County it being
one hundred one and a quarter acres
more or less and the other half of said
lot which I value at seven hundred and
fifty dollars.

Item 2^d I likewise leave them two Negro
boys boy and Jesse which I value at a
thousand dollars each they being twins.

Item 3^d Likewise my four horses which
I value at two hundred and twenty five
dollars and my buggy which I value
at one hundred.

Item 4th I likewise leave them my Negro
Woman Woman Rhoda and two
children Amos a boy and Ann a girl
which I value at nine hundred dollars
and their increase.

Item 5th I also leave all my household
and Kitchen Furniture to them which
includes bedding cooking utensils
Clock &c and three cows and calves
to be selected by my beloved wife and also
my farming utensils and one Road wagon
and six two cows and fourteen hogs
the above property I give and bequeath to my
said beloved wife and children relinquishing
all my interest and control to them
former agreement to the following regulation,
When my youngest child becomes of age -

= then the above property to be equally divided
between My wife and child above. The property
to be kept together and used til the above named
period arriving for the Mutual Maintenance
of the Minor children and their education
and comfortable support of my beloved wife
And in case of My wife's decease or contentions
among my said children the surplus of the
property over and above the support and
education of the children (which I wish to
be equal) to be equally divided among my
said children

Item 6th It is my wish that my beloved wife
and my son in law, William H. Boyd to carry
into effect this my last will and Testament &
request of them that they after paying my
just debts to equally divide all my property
unless that which is above named, equally
among my children, as well that which may
come to me by legacy as that which I now
hold or may make
