2d. As touching my estate that all my just debts be paid.

3d. I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Sally Kelly all my estate both real and personal, household and Kitchen Furniture.

4. I constitute and appoint my Wife Sally Kelly my Executrix to this my Will.
