I hereby making all former wills
Testaments Grants and Deeds this to be
My last will and Testament

First That and in consideration of the Sum
of Six hundred dollars I hereby give grant
and convey unto my son James H. Dupree
the right and title to a certain Negro Boy
named Fred and of yellow complexion and
about sixteen years of age. The said sum of
Six hundred dollars to be paid by my son
James H. Dupree for the benefit of my
three Grant Children to wit Charles William
William Hayden and Elizabeth Fleming Dupree
sons of John Dupree deceased and that
my son James H. Dupree is to pay two
hundred dollars of the above Six hundred
to each of my three above mentioned Grant
Children at they severally become of age
with lawful interest upon the same
commencing within one year from the
date of this instrument. The remainder
of my estate I wish equally distributed
between my four Children to wit Charles
James William H. Dupree Senior
Elizabeth S. Spradlin James H. Dupree and
my three Grant Children to wit Charles
William William Hayden and Elizabeth
Fleming Dupree children of John Dupree
deceased. My three Grant Children to have
an equal portion of my estate with my
four Children, reserving the negro Boy =

executor.
