1st My will and desire is I give and during my soul to the almighty God the author thereof and recommend my body to the dust from whence it came and to a decent burial

I give and bequeath my land lot N^o two hundred and sixty nine in the ninth district of formerly Troup County now Meriwether County whenon David W. Woyd now lives the above named land to be sold and equally divided between all my heirs to wit: William Woyd Joseph Woyd and Mary-Achison John Woyd Hugh Woyd Kenneth A. Rosannah Hopu and David W. Woyd and Fanny Tidwell I nominate and appoint my son William Woyd my Executor to this my last will and Testament carried into effect Given under my hand and seal this 8th day of December 1840
