do make and ordain this my last will
and Testament in doing which I desire
that (after my decease) my body be buried
in a decent and christian like manner
suitable to my condition in life. My soul
I recommend to god who gave it
hoping to receive eternal life through
the merits of his son Jesus Christ my
Redeemer.

Item 1st After my death I desire all my
Just debts should be paid out of
my estate as early as possible

Item 2nd As I have heretofore given off to my
children Eliza F. Griffin Mary K.
Roper Mary A. F. Lovejoy and Laura
Lovejoy each the sum of Seven hundred
dollars and to Elizabeth F. Roper the sum
of six hundred dollars and to James A.
Hutton the sum of five hundred and
seventy five dollars and to John Hutton
the sum of two hundred and eighty two
dollars being amount paid for him (as
 tuition while at college and while a minor)
and to my youngest son Francis F. Hutton
I have given nothing. I Will and direct
that the sum of thirteen hundred and
forty three dollars or a sum sufficient to
make all my children equal in dividing
the amount before mentioned, charging each
one with the amount given, which will leave =

out of said sum one hundred dollars to
Elizabeth J. Popper, one hundred and twenty five
dollars to James C. Hutton, four hundred and
eighteen to John Hutton (if the legatee claims
that he shall pay the fractions above mentioned)
and if they do not he is entitled to the sum
of seven hundred dollars, and to Francis
J. Hutton the sum of seven hundred dollars
he has and heretofore received nothing, and
that said sum be raised out of my estate
by sale or otherwise, at the discretion of my
executors.

Item 3rd I will give and bequeath to my
Daughter Nancy H. Popper Wife of
Asa Popper in addition to the sum before
named my Negro boy Sam about nineteen
years old.

Item 4th I will and bequeath to my
Daughter Elizabeth J. Popper Wife
James Popper in addition to the sum
before named the sum of ten dollars.
Item 5th I will and direct that at the balance
of my estate, real and personal of
every description that I may die possessed
of be sold in twelve months credit and
the proceeds to be equally divided among
six of my children (to wit) Flora Francis Hutton
Mary C. J. Lovejoy James C. Hutton Laura D.
Lovejoy John C. Hutton and Francis J. Hutton
Shaw and John A. Hutton.

Item 6th I hereby appoint my two Sons
James and John Hutton my Executors
of this my last will and Testament
confiding in them for the faithful
execution of the same. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day of March 1859.
