

George Meriwether being appointed for all crimes to die, and being a Widow of John Watts deceased and knowing that I am getting old and have been for sometime in a very declining state of health, though now in sound and disposing mind and memory I do therefore think proper to make this my last will and Testament in manner and form following (Wit)

After paying all of my just debts I give and bequeath to my said named children

(I give to Hannah A. Watts one Negro Woman by the Name of Pacey and her two children, and the said Hannah A. Watts is to give to Elizabeth Watts Three hundred Dollars to make her part up equal due the first day of November 1853, 1

Also I give to John Watts one Negro man by the Name of Freeman and the said John Watts is to give to Thomas Watts one horse and Bridle Saddle to make his part equal

Also I give to Milly Watts one Negro Man by the Name of Jacob and the said Milly Watts is to give to Sarah Watts Fifty-dollars due when the said Sarah Watts comes of age to make her part equal also

I give to the said Sarah Watts one Negro Man by the Name of William

Also I give to Elizabeth Watts one old Negro Woman by the Name of Charity

Also I give to Thomas Watts one Negro Man by the Name of Anthony (Wit) The above named property I give to the above named children and their heirs, and no other person not to be allowed to dispose of said property in any manner And I duly constitute and appoint David Meriwether the Executor of this my last will and Testament
