I, Selina Wuddleston of the State  
and County aforesaid, being weak in body but  
of sound and perfect mind and memory, do  
make and publish this my last will and Testame-  
nt, in manner and form following, that is to  
say First I give and bequeath unto my youngest  
son George Barry Wuddleston all that lot or  
parcel of land whereon I now live, it being  
the west half of lot eighty three (83) in ninth  
district of originally Township now Meriwether  
County. Containing one hundred one and one fourth  
acres be the same more or less. To have and to hold  
to him the George Barry his heirs and assigns  
forever. I do also give and bequeath unto my  
three sons Joseph Allen Wuddleston, Miles John  
Wuddleston, and George Barry Wuddleston  
all my interest in the estate of my late husband  
Allen Wuddleston deceased, it being one undivided  
third part of the same to be equally divided between  
them. All the rest of my estate goods & chattels  
of what kind or nature soever, after the pay-  
ment of all my just debts, I give and bequeath

unto my younger son George Barry Huddleston  
 except my Household furniture, which I give  
 unto my three sons which has been above named  
 to be equally divided between them. And I  
 hereby appoint James A. Pruden sole Executor  
 of this my last will and Testament, and hereby  
 revoking all former wills by me made.
