In the name of God, Amen: I Solomon Phillips of the County of Meriwether and

State of Georgia being of sound mind and memory blessed be God, and calling into mind the mortality of the body and that it is allotted for all men once to die, do make this my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows viz.

1st I give my wife Martha W. Phillips a portion of a Lot of Land No (17) nineteen in the Eleventh District of Meriwether County, Georgia as follows, Commencing at the north West Corner of said lot and running South on the original land line to where the road that leads into Singsfields land now crosses said line, and from thence Eastward so as to include the House lot and Stables at the residence, and thence Eastward so as to include a cross fence on the North of the South Orchard then East to the Creek and down said run of said Creek to the beginning corner, containing Fifty Acres more or less to have and to hold together with all the Appurtenances therunto belonging during her natural life and at her death to revert back to my Children named in this will,

2nd I also give my wife Martha W. Phillips One Chestnut Horse now in my possession called Rock and my Buggy and Harness, One Cow and Calf to be selected by herself, One Cow and Pig and two Hogs one year old also selected by herself: all the Corn wheat and Godder and other provender now on my place also all the family supplies of Bacon, Flour, Lard &c all the Stock to be fed with the provender the present year, to have and to hold during her life and at her death to revert to my Estate and divided as expressed in first Article.

3rd I also give to my wife Martha W. Phillips all my Household and Kitchen furniture of every description during her natural life and at her death to revert to my Estate and to be divided as set forth at first Article,

4th I give to my Daughter Eleanor Reed Twenty Dollars, to raised from my Estate to buy her a bed,

5th It is my will and desire that all the balance of my property both Real & Personal be equally divided share and

either by sale and division or agreement among themselves
