Item I do hereby give and bequeath unto
my son Francis Hudson all my estate

paying all my just debts - And I do further
give and bequeath unto my said son Francis
Hudson all the debts and demands due
& owing or coming to me whatsoever at the
time of my death. In Witness of and confirm-
ation hereof I hereunto set my hand and
affix my seal this the sixth day of August
eighteen hundred & thirty four.
