Georgia & County of Meriwether
I give and bequeath or bequeath
unto Elizabeth Capel my widow
one negro man by the name
of Luke about forty years of
age and one negro girl by
the name of White

Years old - one sorrel horse
one Arabian Wagon and all
the stock consisting of cattle
and hogs now belonging to me
also seventy five acres of land
including the houses in which
I now live the land to be
run off the East side of Lot
No sixty four (64) in the first
District originally known as
Meriwether County the line to run
from North to South of said Lot
so as to get seventy five acres.
The above property to belong
to said Elizabeth untill her
death at which time the above
named negro by name Luke
I give and bequeath unto my
youngest son (James Jackson
Capel) I also give and bequeath
unto said James Jackson at
the death of my widow the
above described seventy five
acres of land. I give and
bequeath unto Vernon Giles and
Anno Giles Ten Dollars each
of my estate. The ballance of
my estate I give and bequeath
unto (John Rosier, John Hinson
William Solomon Capel and
Benjamin Watson Capel) all
the ballance of my estate to
be equally divided except (John
Hinson) who shall receive
one hundred dollars less
than each of the last named
persons or children.
