Miller County Wills 1871-1925
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Last will and testament of Elizabeth Stegall.

I, Elizabeth Stegall, of said State and County being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all wills heretofore made by me.

Item 1. I wish my Executor or soon as possible after my death to pay all my just and honest debts.

Item 2. I give and bequeath to my daughter, Mrs Luella Ritchie the following property to-wit: Thirteen acres of land off of Lot of land No. Ninety six in the 26th District of Miller County, Ga; also Twenty acres of land off of Lot of land No. Ninety seven in the 26th Dist. of said county and also all my household and kitchen furniture except that hereinafter mentioned.

Item 3. I give and bequeath to Luella Ritchie, Sarah Montgomery, Horrell Harris and Mary Patchbor equally one feather bed and fixtures, such as sheets, pillows and quilts, said feather beds and fixtures to be divided equally among said parties.

Item 4. I give and bequeath to my beloved husband Frank Stegall, one feather bed with fixtures such as sheets, pillows and quilts.

Item 5. I desire that the balance of my real estate consisting of one hundred and thirty-six acres of land off of Lot of Land No. Ninety seven in the 26th Dist. of said county be sold immediately after my death and that the proceeds be equally divided between all the children and my beloved husband to-wit; Norrell Harris, Lulla Ritchie, Mary Batchelor, Sally Montgomery and Frank Stegall, each receiving share and share alike.

Item 6. I hereby give and bequeath to my husband Frank Stegall my horse and buggy.

Item 7. I hereby give and bequeath to my husband Frank Stegall one cow and calf and any and all hogs that I may have at the time of my death.

Item 8. I give and bequeath to my daughter Lulla Ritchie any and all cattle that I may have at the time of my death other than the cow and calf mentioned in item seven above.

Item 9. I hereby appoint my beloved husband Frank Stegall, executor of this my will.
