I Henry Hand of said County make this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

Item 1st It is my desire & will that my body be buried in a decent and christian like manner.

Item 2nd It is my will & desire that my executor hereinafter named pay all of my just debts that I may owe at the time of my death, as soon thereafter as he can do so and I direct that all my money that I may have on hand at the time of my death together with such notes accounts and other evidence of debt that may then be owing to me be forthwith appropriated to the payment of my debts and the expenses of the Administration of my estate or so much thereof as is necessary for that purpose. I further will that if what money, notes accounts and other evidence of debt that I may have owing to me at the time of my death is not sufficient to pay my debts and the expenses of Administration on my estate under this will then it is my will and desire that my several Legatees hereinafter named contribute from their Legacies pro rata according to the value thereof to the payment of such debts & expenses.

Item 3. I give & bequeath to my daughter Mrs Alice Lewis Lot of Land No. 369 in 13th District of Miller County.

Item 4th I give & bequeath my daughter Mrs Sarah Wolf Lot of Land No. 329 in 13th District of said County.

Item 5th I give & bequeath to my son ...

of Lot of Land No 370 in 13th District of said County. said 100 acres of Land to be so Laid off as to extend a crop- said Lot from the south line of said Lot. to the north line thereof and to be of the same width all across said Lot. It is my further will if the said Vestee C. Roberts ever sets up any claim to or attempts to recover from Mrs Alice Grimes or her heirs or assigns the Lands given to her or any part thereof in the 3rd Item of this my will then the Land given to said Vestee C. Roberts in this Item is to go to & become the property of said Alice Grimes or her heirs

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my son Replins M. H. and all of Lot of Land No 370 in 13th District of said County except that portion above given to my Grand son Vestee C. Roberts

Item 7th I give & bequeath to my Grand daughter Mattie Newberry 10 acres of land to be Laid off out of the South East corner of Lot of Land No 350 in 13th Dist of said County

Item 8th I give and bequeath unto my three Grand (Children) Daughters, Ida Roberts, Charlott Roberts and Mattie Newberry, share and share alike all that part of Lot of Land Number 311 in 13th District of said County that I now own it being 170 acres. It is my further will if the said Ida Roberts & Charlott Roberts, ever sets up any claim to or attempts to recover from Mrs Alice Grimes or her heirs or assigns the Land given to her or any part thereof

herin given to them the said Ida & Charlotte
is to go to & become the property of said Alice
Grimes or her heirs

Item 9th I give & bequeath to my son, Jno. H. Sand
all of the remainder and residuary part
of my Estate be it real personal, mixed
or Chasen in whole or of what ever Character
it may be. Subject to these Conditions
he is to take Care of my wife Martha a Hand
& Who is his Mother during her life Time and
to Care for her & provide for her in a Confidential
manner. during her life Time and at her
death to give her a decent & Christian like burial
The said John H. Sand is not to have any power
to sell, or convey any of the property given to him
in this Item of my will during the life time
of my said wife without her consent thereto
Item 10th. I appoint Elledge Robert Graden of
his Children & Frank Newberry, Guardian
of his Child with power to receive from
my Executor their respective shares of their
Children interest in my Estate as above given
them with power to manage the same until
said children become of age or marry.

Item 11. I appoint my son Jno. H. Sand my Executor
To carry out this my will

Item 12. It is my will that if any of my Legatees
herein named, attempts to break the same, that this
will be null and void as to him and his heirs
I declare the above foregoing writing containing
12 Items and 5 Pages in all and signed by me
