I have my wife's name in mind that there is children's part

 before it is divided and after her death to go to the
 heirs that hold the seeds to said land. I desire that
 my will immediately closed up by 6 centon here upon
 after named and divided equally among my wife and
 the children and share a third each wife and
 the children I desire that direct that the be divided

 3rd I desire and direct that after my death all my just
 debts be paid as soon as convenient by my Executor

 my wife and Executor will sell enough of my property
 I shall not have sufficient funds on hand to pay the
 debts my Executor is to pay after all
 debts is paid to have the balance of my Personal property
 appraised and divided as before said among my children
 as here before stated I further direct that my Executor
 return to my Court in his last report stating
 further than probate this will unless my heirs
 shall find that he is wronging my Estate in any
 event I direct that he make annual returns to the
 Court of Ordinary as the said Court requires
 do this to save my Estate this expense which in
 many cases is a great deal
 4th I hereby nominal and appoint my son as Executor
 as the executor of my cash will and be to him hoping
 and trusting I have herein approved in him will
 be faithfully executed and that I commit my soul to
 the God that gave it and my body I desire to be
 buried wherever my family desires it in as much
