

Will of Susan Adams.

I Susan Adams of The State and County
aforesaid being of Sound Mind and Memory.
make this my last will and Testament.

1 I will and direct that all my property, whether
Real or personal, notes, or accounts, or choses
in action, be kept together by my husband
J.M. Adams until my youngest child shall
become Twenty One Year of Age. Also that
the interest which I have in the estate of
my father, which estate is in the State of
Tennessee, shall be recovered, collected
and received by my said husband, and
that he shall keep the same together with
the property above mentioned, until my
youngest child shall become Twenty One
Year of Age. And I expressly direct that
my said husband, J.M. Adams, shall keep,
direct, & control without any restriction,
all of said property for my children and
himself, until the majority of my youngest
child.

I direct that my said husband shall have
the right and power to give any part or
said property to any one of my child.
And said gift not to amount to more
than the whole interest of such child in
said property if he may choose.

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be made to such child or an advancement out of such property. And be charged as such.

3 I direct that at the majority of my youngest child, or if it shall die before it arrives at majority, then at the majority of all my children living, all of my said property shall be equally divided between my said husband and my said children. And if any of my said children shall die, before such division of said property, and shall leave surviving them child or children, then such child or children shall receive the interest which its deceased parent would have received, if it had not died. And if any of my heirs shall die without a child or children, then all my property aforesaid shall go to the surviving heirs.

4 I direct, that in the event my said husband shall deem it necessary, for the best interest of himself and my children, to sell, exchange or in any other way dispose of any part of my said property, he shall have the power to do so. And my children shall not hold him accountable for such property. I direct that he shall have the same power to manage, control and dispose of any part of my property, that I have or might have if I were living.

5 I hereby constitute and appoint my said husband, The said J. M. Adams, Executor of this will, and to
