do make this my last will and testament, hereby
revoaking any and all wills heretofore at any time
made by me.

Item I wish my executors hereinafter named
as soon as possible after my death, to pay my
just and honest debts, if a sale of property shall
be necessary I wish them to select for sale that
which can be most advantageously used for that

purpose, and I authorize them to sell the same at
public or private sale as they may see fit and proper.

Item II I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Nancy Ann ~~Womble~~ the following property to wit
one Bedstead and contents, including one feather bed,
two mattresses, two pillows, one pair of sheets one
counterpane and six quilts the above being the bed
in the room that my wife and I are accustomed
to occupy, also one half dozen split bottom chairs
two rocking chairs and one walnut Bureau.

Item III I will that after the above described property
shall have been delivered to my wife that all
the remaining portion of my estate both real
and personal, including lands, houses mortgages
notes, monies, accounts choses in action shall be
equally and equitably divided between all my
children and my wife share alike that is to
say my wife shall receive ~~one~~ child's portion

the foregoing provisions for my wife are intended
to be given in lieu of all dower.

Item. 20. - In case my wife shall depart this life before me I desire and will that all of my property herein described in the foregoing three paragraphs shall be equally and Equitably divided between my children.

Item. V. I hereby appoint two of my beloved children David B and Eusemer O. Womble executors of this my last will and testament, and as compensation for their service as such I will that they receive the sum of fifty dollars each, to be deducted from the property herebefore willed in the third Item.

Item. VI. It is my desire and will that my said executors shall not be required to give any bond as executors and they are hereby released from making any returns to the ordinary of said County of their said acts and doings in testimony whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal this 11th day of May 1903
