venient during the three years, and that
his tuition be paid by my Executors.
And of the monies arising from sale

Three years from my demise that all of my
property be divided among my children and

I have ^{given the my wife} Mary D. Bush to have a certain promissory
note I now hold against W & Mc
Mullin for 32⁰⁰ Thirty two dollars in
hired of cattle of her used by me
Item 7th I hereby create my beloved sons
James F. and Alexander D. Bush.

best advantage. And I humbly invoke
the Blessings of God on them in their
labors, and on all my dear children
