Copy Will of James Lee

In the Name of God Amen.

I James Lee do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following  
First I resign my soul into the hands of Almighty God, hoping and believing in a remission of my sins by the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ, and my body I commit to the earth to be buried in the grave yard at Union Hill Church by my Executor hereinafter named and my worldly estate I give and divide as follows.

Next I will lot of land No 1122. 2-1-1 to be sold at private sale or public outcry, and the proceeds of the sale of said lot of land, with the sale of the Sack and waggon to pay off all the debts against the estate of the testator, and also the balance of the proceeds to be converted to the support of the family for the present year 1863.

Next I will to Mr. J. G. Lee, S. G. Lee, Mr. A. Lee, N. B. Lee my bodily heirs Seventy five dollars each. Ann Atkeys Child will receive such a part as his Mother would have received had she been in life.

Next I will to my wife Susannah Lee all my household goods, and lot No 1122. - household goods.

... and ~~the~~ other furniture. And also the line ~~of~~ <sup>during her natural life or widow-</sup> hood, to be used by her, ~~her~~ <sup>after the death of my</sup> wife. My Executor will proceed to sell all my Estate both real and personal at public outcry, and the proceeds of said Sale to be equally divided between my heirs, such as are in life, the Children of them that are dead will receive such a part as though their parents were in life.

Next. I will and appoint my son J. W. Lee of Forsythe County, Ga. Executor of my last will and testament.
