A disposition of the property which I have
been blessed with, hereby make this as my
last will and testament.

Item 1st I desire that my Speculator hereinafter
Appointed pay all my just debts, out of my
estate as soon after my death as possible.

Item 2^d I hereby give and bequeath to
my wife, Cynthia all my estate both real
and personal, to dispose of as she may think
proper without limitation, after the
payment of my debts, in fee simple.

Item 3rd I hereby constitute and appoint
my beloved wife Cynthia Speculator
to this my last will and testament, this 10th day
of March 1860.
